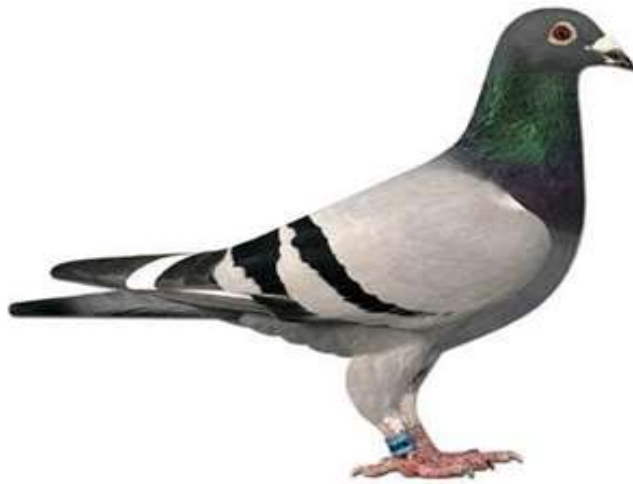

All members and guest clubs of the KZN Combine are invited to support this fundraiser which takes the form of a Squeaker Sale to be held on Sunday the 13th of November 2016 at Pinetown Racing Pigeon Club, New Germany Sports Club, Broadway Street,(Off Shepstone Road) New Germany.

The race format will be over 2 races with the two races as hotspots carrying prize money of R 5,000 per hotspot on the respective routes on a winner takes all basis. The first leg will be from a North route liberation point Yearling series and the second leg will be from a West route liberation point Yearling series in the 2017 Combine Race programme. Both races will be from a distance of approximately 500 kms from Durban. Sale pigeons will accrue points from one race to the next and the bird with the highest points will take 1st prize. A grand total of R 60,000 will be available for prize money over the 2 legs of the race and the Nomination race.

THERE WILL BE 12 ENVELOPES FOR AUCTION. THE NUMBER OF RINGS IN THE ENVELOPES WILL VARY BETWEEN 4 AND 9. LUCK OF THE DRAW!

BREAKDOWN OF ENVELOPES WILL BE AS FOLLOW:

ONE WITH 9, TWO WITH 7, TWO WITH 6, THREE WITH 5 AND FOUR WITH 4

IN ADDITION A NUMBER OF INDIVIDUAL RINGS WILL BE AUCTIONED.

IN ADDITION TO THE SALE OF SQUEAKERS 20 TOP QUALITY RACE BIRDS HAVE BEEN DONATED FOR AUCTION BY THE HIGHLY ACCLAIMED KITCHENBRAND LOFTS AS WELL AS 2 PAIRS OF TOP QUALITY STOCK BIRDS FROM THIS FAMOUS LOFT. PEDIGREES OF ALL THESE DONATED BIRDS WILL BE PUBLISHED PRIOR TO THE ALLIANCE SALE. THESE BIRDS COME FROM THE MILLION DOLLAR/BIRDY HERITAGES-SOUGHT AFTER BY ALL WITH RACE RESULTS AT THEIR LOFTS AND ONE LOFT RACES TO BACK UP THE PIGEONS' POTENTIAL. MARK KITCHENBRAND WILL BE IN ATTENDANCE AT THE AUCTION AND WILL BE ABLE TO GIVE PROSPECTIVE BUYERS BACKGROUND TO THE DONATED BIRDS TO BE AUCTIONED. HERE IS AN OPPORTUNITY TO ACQUIRE VERY SOUGHT AFTER AND HARD TO OBTAIN QUALITY PIGEONS. YOU CANNOT AFFORD TO LOSE OUT ON THE OPPORTUNITY TO ACQUIRE SUCH QUALITY PIGEONS.

IN ADDITION ONE FREE ENTRY INTO THE DINOGENG ONE LOFT RACE WILL BE AUCTIONED ON THE DAY AS WELL AS A NUMBER OF FREE ENTRIES INTO THE NATIONAL ONE LOFT RACE IN BLOEMFONTEIN.

BASIC RULES:

- It is a requirement for all FLYING members of Zululand clubs, the NPS Club and the Duzi/MRPC/Ixopo club known collectively as the Alliance Clubs to place 2 squeakers on the sale.
- Non Alliance Club members are welcome to pen up to two birds on the auction. Non Alliance Club members may also purchase birds without placing a bird on the sale.
- If 2 squeakers are placed on the sale you will be entitled to purchase 2 sale rings for R 500 for the two, cash only on the day. These rings are non transferable. Birds purchased on the auction may be placed in another member's loft if that member flies in the combine and a prior arrangement and agreement has been made between the purchaser and the member who will be flying the purchased bird. Prize money will be paid to the purchaser of the pigeon, irrespective of from whose loft it is raced.
- The age of the birds: Birds may not be younger than 28 days old; if a bird is found to be younger than 28 days old it will be removed from the auction. The bird cannot be old enough that it has dropped a flight; if a flight has been dropped the bird will be removed from the auction.
- Nominations: Nominations will not be given to each bird purchased but will apply to the R 500 rings only. A nomination will only be given if the bird wearing one of the R 500 rings cannot partake in the final sale race. For example, if you purchase two R500 sale rings and lose one or both of these birds you will be entitled to replace them and race in the nomination race for the nomination prize money. Your race sheet under nominations must provide the number of sale bird for which a nomination is being flown e.g. 'AN' (RING NUMBER OF LOST BIRD). If this is not provided the nomination pigeon will be disqualified. We need to be able to prove that the sale ring bird didn't take part in the sale race. Sales birds need to be marked as 'AS' on the race sheet. A nomination bird can only be entered into the nomination race if a R500 ring bird was lost. Birds rung with the R500-00 rings will be entitled to participate in the main two legs of the competition as well for the grand prize. An Alliance Sale bird or a bird wearing the R500 rings will be entitled to be nominated as a nomination bird in the final race.
- The sales races will take part over two races with the first leg from a North Route point to be determined and the second leg from a West route point to be determined. Both liberation points will be in the vicinity of 500 kms from Durban. The Nomination race will be on the West race. The GCA Committee reserves the right to change race points and dates should it deem necessary. The 1st and 2nd legs of the sale bird races will be hotspots where prize money will be paid to the sale bird winner of each hotspot. All sale birds that are clocked will receive points. The amount of positions will be determined by the quantity of sale birds entered into the first race and will remain the same for the two races. The race will close on the day or adjusted by the Alliance Club Committee in required situations. If the complete race is a over night, the race will stay open until declared closed by the SANPO rules. If 100 sale birds are raced in the first leg the winning bird will accrue 100 points the second bird 99 and the last bird one point. Points are carried over to the next leg on the same basis. Should a sale bird not being clocked and not score it can still race in the next race but it will carry nil points from the previous race. The sale bird that accumulates the most points over the three races will be adjudged the winner and receive 1st prize of R 40,000. The individual winner of the two races will receive the hot spot prize of R5 000-00 per race. The nomination prize will pay R 10 000-00 for first place on the selected race. A total of R 10,000 on the two hotspots will be paid out. Prize money will be split 80/20 to the Trainer and Breeder. If you are the trainer and breeder you take the whole amount for the respective position. Nominated birds will not compete for the hot spot prize. In 2016 the Nomination race will take place over the last leg flown in the series.

The Alliance Club Committee reserves the right to adjust prize money should the revenue collected not meet expected targets.

The prize money is calculated on budgeted targets reached.

- All birds clocked must be reported within one hour of clocking and the time may not be out by more than 5min. Further details will be given prior to the start of the races.

Members flying a North scheme only will be accommodated to fly their sale birds in the specific West Race.

All KZNRPC and SANPO rules will apply.
